

**Class Tuition-** \$250.00

Includes:

- Each student also needs to have a textbook pack. Some of the materials can be shared among family members but everyone needs their own logbook, student folder, and workbook. Some instructors require the purchase of corresponding DVD or video.

***Private & Semi-Private Lessons***

Private lessons are tailored to fit your schedule, the instructors, schedule, and available pool times. If scheduling allows, classes can be completed in as little as a week!

Private lessons are one on one and cost \$495

Semi Private lessons are for 2-6 divers and cost is \$395/person

Checkout dives can be arranged on one of our scheduled weekends and referrals are available for you to complete your dives on a planned trip.

***Summer Scuba Camps***

We can certify children as young as 10 years old! And we offer two weeklong Scuba Camps every July and August for kids aged 10-18 at Malvern Prep School in Malvern and Upper MainLine YMCA in Devon.

These camps are weeklong all-day camps for kids. Monday through Thursday, kids spend each morning in a pool and class session followed by a lunch break, and then an afternoon pool and class session. Friday and Saturday are reserved for checkout dives should parents choose to arrange it. We depart for Dutch Springs on Friday morning, do 2 dives that afternoon have a BBQ and camp-out. Then finish the final 2 dives early Saturday morning. Parents are welcome to join the kids for the weekend and can even dive with them, as certified divers on Saturday afternoon!

FAQ

Q. What is the difference between NAUI and PADI?

A. The most noticeable difference between the two is the way they deal with the classroom sessions. PADI uses videos and the instructor supplements the video with any additional information. This way the most important information is taught every time without a doubt. NAUI classes are taught directly by the instructor and is supplemented with visual aids. This way the instructor can speed up or slow the class down depending on how the class is grasping the concepts. The pool sessions for each are very similar and at the end of either class the students are equally qualified.

Q. What if I miss a class?

A. We will be glad to make up one or two classes during one of our other classes, talk to your instructor to arrange a day and time.

Q. What if my schedule doesn't work with your classes?

A. We can schedule semi-private or private lessons to meet your schedule. Call the shop for more details.

Q. What are the age limits for Scuba Diving?

A. PADI will certify at age 10 but with depth restrictions, then at 12 the restrictions are removed. NAUI certifies at age 10. All divers must dive with a parent or legal guardian until age 15 regardless of the certifying agency. When divers reach 15 years old, they no longer are required to dive with a parent but must have parental permission to dive until they are 18.
