Last KDA Meeting: October 16, 2008!

The KDA and the Philadelphia chapter of the Explorer's Club presented Shipwreck explorer, **Barry Clifford**, with an exclusive presentation at the Franklin Institute. Barry was the discoverer of the shipwreck "Whydah", the focus of the "Real Pirates" exhibit currently on display at the Franklin Institute. He brought some unique insight and details about the discovery and preservation of artifacts from the *Whydah*.

Barry was kind enough to come down from Pirate headquarters in Cape Cod, MA and meet us for a private slide show in the Franklin Institute's auditorium followed by a tour of the REAL PIRATES exhibit. He also gave us a taste of another project that he has been working on in Madagascar looking for Captain Kidd's ship. He thinks that he knows where it is but the problem is figuring out which shipwreck is his. The wrecks are piled on top of each other in shallow water right off the coast of the island!

The slave ship *Whydah* began her short life in London, England, in 1715. Less than two years later, now a pirate ship, she sank to the ocean floor off Cape Cod. Using artifacts recovered from the wreck, "Real Pirates: The Untold Story of the *Whydah* from Slave Ship to Pirate Ship" reveals the true story behind this vessel.& the crew of a real pirate ship that started as a slave ship—and gives some insights into the violence and idealism of early eighteenth century piracy.

The exhibition features real stories of the people who populated the Atlantic world in the age of slavery and piracy: artisans and traders from West Africa, slave ship captains and their captives, Native American boat pilots, impoverished sailors from all over Europe, and pirates—including women pirates and John King, a boy no more than 11 years old, who "went on the account." Guests see more than 200 actual *Whydah* artifacts recovered by underwater explorer Barry Clifford, such as treasure from more than 54 ships, gold and silver coins from all over the world, Akan gold jewelry, cannons, swords, pistols, personal belongings, leg iron moldings from shackles, the ship's bell and its massive anchor!

This event was so much fun that we are planning on doing it again next year!

Divers identify shipwreck off Nantucket

NANTUCKET - Divers have identified a shipwreck off Nantucket as a British steamship that sank more than 120 years ago. The SS Newcastle City was carrying cargo when it struck an uncharted shoal en route to New York in 1887. The 26 man crew and a passenger were rescued after rowing to safety.

Diver Eric Takakjian told the Cape Cod Times he'd been looking for the vessel for years because of its unique riggings for both steam and sail. Takakjian and his exploration team, Quest Marine Services, in August found the wreck resting on a sandy bottom, with portions of the bow and stern intact.

Takakjian confirmed the wreck's identity during a dive last weekend after he scraped sea anemones away from the ship's wheel and revealed the engraving "Newcastle City Liverpoole."

He's keeping the wreck's location and depth a secret.


