Sheard is a wreck diver through and through and his involvement in early US deep wreck diving was an inspiration to many today even as he continues to work on his third book. He would like to go to the Solomon Islands, New Guinea, back to the Pacific near Bikini where loads of WWII wrecks are sunk then back to Europe and then those amazing wrecks up in Northern Ireland. He can make even the worst wreck look like a dream – AND you can share these images with your non-wreck diving friends to show them just what you're seeing down there! 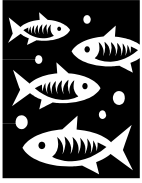
