Last KDA Meeting: August 4, 2010!

Somewhere on St. Vincent there lives an ex-pat who once was a dive guide in Papua New Guinea and before that worked for an oil company after serving in the US Marine Corps. Other than the fact that he owns Dive St. Vincent (since 1984), he probably won't give you the time of day. But if you are interested in what HE is interested in; i.e. small underwater creatures, their habits and where they live, and just as Arch McNamara found out, Bill Tewes will take you out to see something most unique in OUR side of the world! Critters that usually live in the OTHER hemisphere can actually be found in the "Critter Capital of the Caribbean": St. Vincent. Their legendary critter-finder, Bill Tewes is so famous that he is actually pictured on a postal stamp! Many visitors are there for the sailing and divide their time between the wind-washed water, the main island, and Young Island offshore, or across the waves to the Grenadines, but WE know what they are missing! Pregnant cleaner shrimp (apparently ALL of them are), Pisto (or snapping) shrimp, LOTS of seahorses and subspecies, anemone, flamingo tongues, fingerprint cyphoma, hermit, arrow and decorator crabs, a sailfish blenny and a mirror WILL fight, cowfish, pufferfish, peacock flounder, porcupine fish, trunkfish, lizardfish, morays & trumpetfish, bluebar jawfish and yellowhead, highhat (looks like a spotted drum) longlure flogfish or anglerfish – my favorite – LOVE that twirling little *fishing pole* attached to their head, hairy frogfish, octopus, night basket star and flying buttresses (just made that one up)! The 20 acres of botanical gardens are the oldest in the western hemisphere (since 1765) and are home to St. Vincent Parrots and Capt. Bly's breadfruit tree! Interestingly in Ft. Charlotte the British canons all were pointed at the town and NOT at the sea! Fly to Barbadoes or Puerto Rico – NOT thru Florida! Our man Arch may be a Wills Eye Institute Retina Surgeon by day, but come KDA meeting, this avid underwater photographer turns into a splendid showman issuing digital proof that he has lugged his housed Nikon D200 to as many dive sites on the planet as he could. Although Arch did not discover any new species on this trip, Bill Tewes has done so throughout his career having pointed out many a "NIB" during the dives - that means NOT IN BOOK (Paul Human's) NOT New in Box you gun people. 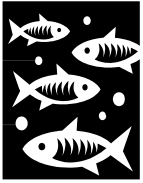

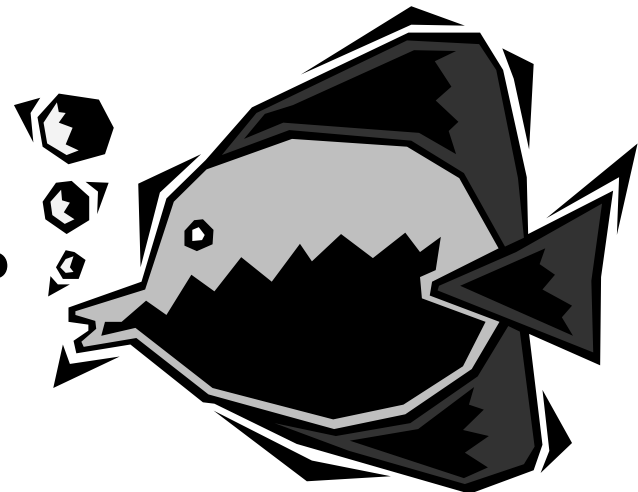
