GREAT LAKES SHIPHUNT

On the bottom of Lake Huron for over a century and preserved at a depth of 315 feet lies the Schooner *M.F. Merrick* and the freighter *Eturia*. Our team was lucky enough to be the first to explore the sites and lay eyes on the virgin wrecks. Our unique team consisted of five high school students, NOAA, and Sony to create the documentary Project *Shiphunt* that aired on *Current TV*. The five students were mentored in how to use modern day technology such as multi beam sonar, ROV's and technical divers to find and explore shipwrecks. **Becky Kagan Schott and David Schott** are Emmy Award winning videographers that own *Liquid Productions, LLC*. They specialize in underwater videography, still photography and High Definition 3D video in any aquatic environment including caves, deep wrecks and marine wild life. Their projects have taken them all over the world from documenting historic wrecks in the Great Lakes, Japan and Truk Lagoon to filming wild dolphins, whales and great white sharks...cageless. Concordville Inn was the place this year for the annual KDA Christmas Dinner! Our gracious thanks to Stacy for arranging and organizing the whole affair! And for the first time, we integrated a guest speaker into the evening – not just ANY guest speaker – but one of our FAVORITES from years past – our Very Special Guest Speaker, celebrated National Geographic underwater cameraman, world-famous for his shark imaging, **Nick Caloyianis!** Having attended ALL 26 of our KDA Christmas Dinners, I think that this was just one of the best! Where else can you spend an intimate evening in a private diving room with 40 of your favorite wreck divers, dining on great food and listening to stories and adventure with a world-class underwater photographer! (Well, we have Evelyn and her non-ceasing nagging of our Guest Speaker for THAT!) He presented his two favorite topics: *Sharks 'n Shipwrecks* (at the moment, ours was Surf 'n Turf). The grey seal population in New England was almost completely wiped out in Colonial days. There were only around 5,000 of this now protected species in the late '60's from Sable Island, Nova Scotia to Chatham Beach, Cape Cod. Their protected status received in 1997 has brought them back so they now number a quarter of a million (now THAT'S a seal of approval)! But guess who else is back because their food source is back?? The Great White Sharks! They saw 20 of them one day just off the beach of that small New England town – and where was that movie, *Jaws*, shot – hands, anyone????!!!! You've been warned. 3500 pounds and 18-20' long – longer than there was viz! And into the shark cage they go to gain some famous photography – who knew a great white was going to slam down on the top of the cage going after bait and get trapped thus damaging it and shortening Nick by a few precious feet! Lucky for them the cage didn't sink and he lived to bring us the tale of the *Warship Kronan*, a 1676 flagship of the Swedish Navy that sunk in 90' in battle in the nearly fresh-water Baltic Sea, thus preserving the magnificent artifacts for over 300 years! Her first salvors were divers who wore leather suits and drank Vodka to keep warm – we warmed to the tale! And, one artifact to another, Nick presented Evelyn with a special commemorative Italian Lira – recovered from the safe of the *Andrea Doria* by and designed by **Peter Gimbel**. Thanks Nick. Always a pleasure!

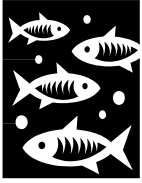
